NOTES FOR PARENTS/CARERS

All holiday clubs will be individually priced due to activity fees and differing hours, please ask club leader for more information. Booking will be on a first come first serve basis. For more information about the number of spaces per club please ask the appropriate club leader. Clubs may be cancelled if there is lack of interest.

Club description

Café Club is a holiday club version of *Grove Cottage @ Thirst Café*. During the school term time Thirst Café is open to the general public and our Grove Cottage Members two days a week but unfortunately during the school holiday it is only open for ages 18 and under. Café Club is available for Grove Cottage Members 18+ based at Grove Cottage. This club is encouraging members who can be left independently and welcomes those who can't to attend with their support workers & carers to come along too. There will be a limited food & drink menu including basic hot and cold drinks, sandwiches, crisps and cakes. Admission fee (to be paid on the door) includes full use of facilities Nintendo wii, pool table, table tennis, garden area, adult colouring & puzzle sheets and sensory room. Please provisionally book with Freya in advance.

Admissions prices

£10 – includes full use of facilities, lunch (sandwich, crisp & cake of choice) and unlimited hot and cold drinks.

£6 – Includes full use of facilities and snack (crisp or cake of choice) unlimited hot & cold drinks

£4 – includes full use of facilities and unlimited hot & cold drinks

Can I ask everyone not to bring external food due to allergies of other Grove Cottage Members that use the building. We can cater for allergies with 48hrs advance.

Get Active Holiday Club is available to any Grove Cottage Member 14+. During school term time our club leader plans sports activities that take place weekly in the same location however Get Active Holiday Clubs are all trips out to places that help us stay active and have fun, for example bowling & trampoline parks etc. The prices may vary due to admission fees and travel, prices available closer to the time.

Cottage Creates Holiday Club is available to any Grove Cottage Member aged 8+. During the term time every week is a different activity or creation, but during the holidays we use the multiple session to create one themed piece or series of creations. Activities can involve tie dying, painting, gift making & much more! All 2 hour sessions are £15 each.

Small Play Holiday Club

For children aged 0-12 years. The holiday club provides a space for children with additional needs to play safely. Timings vary and so do activities. Sometime we do go out to local parks, farms and other fun places. Children are to bring their own packed lunch, drinks and snacks. £4 an hour.

Big Play Holiday Club

For children aged 10-19 years of age with complex special educational needs. Provides a space for children to be safe and socialise with others. Children will need to bring their own packed lunch drinks and snacks. £4 an hour

Siblings support group:

(This could change as at the moment it is at trial stage) for the siblings of children with special educational needs. This is a place for them to come and play depending on age. It can be a place to socialise and be around other children who understand what it is like to be a sibling of a child with SEN. Again, age dependant it can be a place for children to talk to professionals about anything that they may want to talk about.

Cottage Crew Holiday Club

A Social Club for 14-25 years. This is a relaxed club with member lead activities such as craft, cooking, karaoke, parties, disco etc The Club also takes trips out in the local area, for example to Pets Corner, the panto, Hatfield Forest, or for a meal out.
